# Itinerary Details\*

## **June 9 – Saturday**

Depart the U.S.A. on our flight to Israel.

## **June 10 - Sunday**

Welcome to Israel! Arrive Ben Gurion Airport; meeting, assistance and transfer to your hotel in vibrant Tel Aviv. Eve: Welcome Dinner at the Maganda restaurant in the Yemenite Quarter.

## **June 11 - Monday Tel Aviv**

Breakfast in the hotel

Drive south to Machon Ayalon for a fascinating glimpse into the activities of the organization known as Haganah. Return to Tel Aviv and drive along the city's main streets; see the colorful shops and bustling sidewalk cafes. Proceed to the newly opened Palmach Museum (subject to schedule).

Continue past the Mann Auditorium, home of the Israeli Philharmonic, Habimah Theatre, the impressive Opera House and Yitzhak Rabin Square, dedicated to the late Prime Minister. On to Independence Hall where Ben Gurion fervently proclaimed Israel's independence in 1948. Afterwards, on to the lovely old 19th-century neighborhood of Neve Zedek — a jewel amongst the surrounding modern skyscrapers.

Walk along the quaint narrow lanes dotted with lovely museums, cultural complexes and quaint shops. Continue to the old port city of Jaffa, magnificently restored. Spend the rest of the afternoon at lively Nahalat Benjamin with its delightful cafes and craft stalls. Overnight in Tel Aviv.

## **June 12 - Tuesday Tel Aviv/Tiberias**

Breakfast in the hotel

Depart Tel Aviv along the coastal highway to ancient Caesarea; explore the astounding Roman and Crusader ruins including the impressive theater and aqueduct. Then, visit Caesarea Harbor, with its thrilling, multi-media presentation — you'll see ancient history come to life! Continue to the artists' village of Ein Hod and meet with an artist in the workshop. Proceed to a Druze village on the Carmel Range for a tour of the settlement and to learn firsthand about the traditions and customs of these unique Israelis. Arrive at an observation point overlooking Haifa for a panoramic view that includes the golden-domed Bahai Shrine. Travel to the Kibbutz Guest House for overnight.

Eve: Dinner in the Guest House.

## **June 13 - Wednesday Tiberias**

Breakfast in the hotel.

Drive to Safed, one of Judaism's holiest cities, where the Kabbalah flourished during the golden age; visit one of the ancient synagogues and the charming Artists' Quarter. Continue on a Jeep tour of the Golan Heights to Mount Ben Tal for a spectacular view of the area including parts of Syria. Proceed to Kazrin, the capital of the Golan, for a tour and enjoy a wine tasting experience at the Golan Winery. In the afternoon arrive at the Canoeing Center on the Jordan River for a kayaking adventure. Return to the Guest House for overnight.

Eve: Dinner in the Guest House .

## **June 14 - Thursday Tiberias/Jerusalem**

Breakfast in the hotel

Depart Tiberias for Bet Shean, an ancient city from the time of King Saul; see the excavated remains of a Roman city. Continue to the site of the ancient synagogue of Beit Alfa with its unique mosaic floor depicting the signs of the zodiac. Proceed to Sakhne with its natural warm springs, pools and picturesque landscapes. Travel along the Jordan Valley to Mount Scopus for a view of Jerusalem and where the traditional “*Shehechyanu*” ceremony will be made. Arrive at the hotel for overnight.

## **June 15 - Friday Jerusalem**

Breakfast in the hotel

Drive to Yad Vashem, memorial to the Holocaust; visit the Museum, Children’s Pavilion and walk along the Avenue of the Righteous. Then, to Mount Herzl to pay respects to Israel’s military heroes. Visit the newly opened Herzl Museum (schedule permitting). Drive via the Supreme Court Building and the Knesset (Parliament) to the Shrine of the Book, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Time to walk through the Israel Museum and the Billy Rose Sculpture Garden; see the Scale Model of ancient Jerusalem. End the day at Mahane Yehuda - the largest outdoor market in the city. Savor the sights and sounds of the local residents doing their last minute Shabbat purchases. Drive to the Western Wall and join the faithful for Kabbalat Shabbat. Tonight enjoy the traditional Shabbat Dinner at the hotel. Overnight in the hotel.

## **June 16 - Saturday Jerusalem**

Shabbat Shalom!! Breakfast in the hotel. Shabbat at leisure in Jerusalem

Optional morning services at one of the many synagogues in the area. Havdalah overlooking the Old City from the Yemin Moshe Windmill. Overnight in Jerusalem.

## **June 17 - Sunday Jerusalem**

Breakfast in the hotel

Start the day with a breathtaking view of the city from the Mount of Olives. Enter the Old City from the Dung Gate; walk to the Western Wall, the only remaining portion of the Second Temple. View the Dome of the Rock then proceed to the restored Jewish Quarter. Walk along the Cardo, the colonnaded main street of Byzantine Jerusalem and visit the Herodian Mansions, a completely excavated residential quarter from 2000 years ago. Continue through the extraordinary Hasmonean Tunnel (tunnel schedule permitting.) Follow the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre; walk through the exotic bazaars with their wondrous aromas. End the day at Mt. Zion to visit the traditional Tomb of King David and the Room of the Last Supper. Overnight in Jerusalem.

## **June 18 - Monday Jerusalem**

Breakfast in the hotel

Travel via the Judean desert and the shores of the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth, to Masada. Ascend by cable car to this last stronghold of the Zealots in their struggle against the Romans. We’ll celebrate children and adult B’nai Mitzvah followed by refreshments. Proceed on a tour of the site including a visit of the palaces of Herod the Great, the synagogue and bathhouse. In the afternoon drive to Ein Boqueq to enjoy lunch at one of the Dead Sea hotels. Then enjoy the opportunity of a float in the “unsinkable” buoyant waters of the Dead Sea or enjoy the hotel swimming pool. Those who wish may avail themselves of the optional spa facilities in the hotel. On the way back to Jerusalem, view the Qumran Caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Overnight in Jerusalem.

## **June 19 - Tuesday Jerusalem**

Breakfast in the hotel

Day at leisure in Jerusalem for last minute shopping or to revisit sites of particular interest.

Eve: Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant followed by the departure transfer to Ben Gurion airport.
